RECOGNITION OF ACHIEVEMENT BY CENTRAL STAFF

Food & Nutrition Services Meets State's Breakfast Challenge The Waterford Schools Food & Nutrition Services Team has been recognized by the Michigan Department of Education for inclusion on the Michigan School Breakfast challenge 2008-2010 Honor Roll. The School Breakfast Challenge was issued to all school districts participating in the School Breakfast Program in 2008 by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction in an effort to increase the number of breakfasts served by a minimum of 50%. The district will be honored for this achievement at the Michigan Association of School Administrators September, 2010 Conference. Congratulations to all members of the Food & Nutrition Services staff for their on-going efforts at promoting student success by providing a nutritious morning meal every school day.

Additional information:

- School breakfast has been offered in every school building since 1995.
- WSD Board of Education was among the first to choose to voluntarily offer breakfast in all buildings, not just those mandated by the state statute.
- Over 450,000 breakfasts were served to our students last year (2009-10 SY)

(MDE has approved that time applied to the service of breakfast in the classroom qualifies as instructional time.)

Assessment Conference - The Administration provided an update on the recent Assessment Conference.

NEW BUSINESS

Reinstatement Modification - The Board of Education approved the recommendation by the Reinstatement Committee, with regard to the modification of the reinstatement decision, of a student previously expelled by the District. The committee recommended that the student be reinstated with conditions. One condition was modified by the committee.

In keeping with Michigan law, a committee consisting of school board members, school administrator, teacher and parent of a pupil in the district reviewed the Reinstatement. After reviewing all facts and information in the matter, and giving careful consideration to the applicable State law, the committee submitted the modified recommendation as stated above.

Oakland County Parent Advisory Representative - Terms for Waterford School District representatives to the Oakland County Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) have expired. Deborah and Greg Simmons were approved by the Board of Education to continue their role on this important committee for the 2010-2011 school year. PAC meetings are held monthly at Oakland Schools.
