



## Mott Senior Wins National Scholastic Art Award

**May 21, 2003 Waterford, Mich.** - Waterford Mott Senior Megan Wright was awarded a National Silver Award in the 2003 National Scholastic Art Awards Competition.

Wright's artwork, a fabricated sterling silver necklace made from silver tubing, won "Best of Show" in the southeastern Michigan Scholastic Art Awards Regional in February and was forwarded to national competition in New York. Her artwork competed with 15,000 pieces from across the country and earned her the National Silver Award.

Wright will be honored at the 2003 Scholastic Art Awards National Ceremony on June 14 at The Kennedy Center for Performing Arts in Washington D.C. She will travel to Washington prior to the ceremony to participate with other national winners in a collaborative project that will be hung at the national ceremony.

Wright will attend the College for Creative Studies where she has just been awarded the President's Scholarship totaling \$24,000, guaranteed for four years. She received an additional \$4,000 for winning this prestigious Scholastic National Silver Award.

Wright is a member of the National Art Honor Society and is taught by art teacher Sheila Lee.
