



District has waited 62 years to add Swimming Pools and Physical Education Additions - Ground Breaking Ceremonies Planned

August 30, 2004, Waterford, Mich. - Waterford School District officials, students, staff, parents, and community members will gather at the site of Waterford Kettering High School, 2800 Kettering Drive at 8:30 a.m. and Waterford Mott High School, 1151 Scott Lake Road, 9:45 a.m., on Wednesday, September 8, 2004, for the official ground breaking ceremonies for the new swimming pools and physical education additions made possible by the 2003 bond election. The community has waited 62 years for pools to be added to the school district facilities.

Each high school will receive swimming pools and physical education additions that will include separate teaching and competition (swimming and diving) areas; separate physical education, team, and family lockers; pool office on deck; and raised spectator seating. These additions will provide educational instruction, athletic practices and competition, community use, and intramural activity.

French Associates, Inc. Architects & Planners, located in Rochester, has been working with the Waterford School District community to complete numerous construction projects, including Kettering and Mott, throughout the district. Funding of this project has been made possible by the successful passage of the June 2003 bond issue.
