



Waterford School District Board of Education Appoints New Trustee

February 27, 2004 Waterford, Mich. - The Waterford Board of Education has appointed Dave Smith to the Board to serve as trustee, replacing Stanley Kurzman who retired effective February 5, 2004. The term of the appointment will expire Tuesday, June 15, the day after the annual school board election.

Smith is the owner of the Dave Smith State Farm Insurance Agency in Clarkston and a graduate of Illinois State University. Smith serves on several committees and boards including the Estate Planning Advisory Board and National Advancement Board, Rochester College; Waterford Foundation for Public Education; Education Advisory Group and Regional Action Board, Oakland Schools; and the North Oakland Medical Centers Foundation Board. Smith is also a volunteer basketball coach for Waterford Parks and Recreation.

Smith has been a Waterford resident since 1997 and resides with wife DeAndrea, sons Kendall (11) and Denton (2) and daughter Rachel (9).

Per state law, the Board must appoint a successor within 30 calendar days of the receipt of the retiring member's dated letter of resignation. Upon approval, the appointee is sworn into office and would immediately assume the position. The June 14 ballot will include three available positions: two four-year terms and one two-year term, which is the balance of Kurzman's unexpired term.
