



## Waterford Mott H.O.T. Program 2005 Youth Group of the Year

January 28, 2005, Waterford, Mich. - Waterford Mott High School's Hazards of Tobacco Program (H.O.T.) was awarded the 2005 Youth Group of the Year by the Waterford Coalition for Youth. Approximately 80 Mott High School students belong to this program which teaches young people about the hazards of tobacco use. They were recognized for their self-directed leadership in this valuable education-based program.

The high school students travel to Waterford middle schools once a week to inspire and interact with sixth grade students. They provide a high school student's perspective on the hazards of smoking and the effects it will have on their lives.

H.O.T. is a state-wide program started by the Karmanos Cancer Institute to reduce smoking by young people.
