Waterford School District Receives 2006-2007 Exemplary Physical Education Award & Obtains Highest Award Level

August 13, 2007, Waterford, Mich. – The Waterford School District has received the Michigan Governor's Council on Physical Fitness, Health, and Sports Exemplary Physical Education Award, Level 8, for the curriculum work the district's staff completed during the 2006-2007 school year. This is the highest and final exemplary level awarded. The Governor's Exemplary Physical Education Award is designed to encourage and reward exemplary programs and curriculum.

During the 1992-93 school year, Governor John Engler charged the newly formed Michigan Governor's Council on Physical Fitness, Health and Sports to develop materials and procedures that will enable schools to establish exemplary physical education programs. Michigan's **Exemplary Physical Education Curriculum Project (EPEC)** was formed in 1994-1995 to accomplish this task.

The award will be presented on Thursday, Nov. 15 at the annual MAHPERD (Michigan Association for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance) Convention in Traverse City.
