Board of Education Approves New Election Date

January 5, 2007, Waterford, Mich. – The Waterford Board of Education, during a public hearing on December 22, voted to hold the regular Waterford Board of Education elections on even-year November election dates, with terms of six years. The Board of Education’s previous elections have been held in May.

The Board also established, for the 2008 election only, that the Waterford Board of Education will hold an election for two (2) six-year terms and two (2) four-year terms. The two candidates with the highest number of votes will fill the six-year seats and the two candidates with the lowest number of votes will fill the four-year terms. Terms expire in 2008 for Board Members Jim Larkin, John Himmelspach, Virginia Poehlman, and Brian Whiston.

By moving the date on even-year November elections, a savings of \$32,000 will be realized and will be no cost to the District, as well as increased voter participation. The Waterford School District is the only school district in Oakland County to move to an even-year election date.
