Kettering Senior Josh Roltsch Named to United States Army All-American High School Marching Band

October 22, 2009, Waterford, Mich. – The United States Army will make an All-American Selection Tour Stop at Waterford Kettering High School on Friday, November 13, at 7:45 a.m. to honor Kettering Senior Josh Roltsch, who was selected for the 2010 All-American High School Marching Band. As a member of the band, Roltsch will receive this selection presentation by Sportslink and the U.S. Army during this assembly.

The U.S. Army All-American Bowl is the premier high school football game in the Nation. Produced by SportsLink, it features the Nation's top high school senior football players and marching musicians. Based on the results of Roltsch's audition and application, he was selected to be one of only eight marching baritone players. Students are selected who exhibit exceptional musicianship, marching achievement, character, and leadership. Students must be active members of their high school band from the time of the nomination through the final performance at the All-American Bowl.

Roltsch will receive a paid trip to San Antonio to march in the halftime performance of the All-American Bowl at the Alamodome on January 9, 2010.
