## **Journalism Education Association Announced Waterford Kettering High School Teacher Brian Wilson Will Receive Distinguished Advisor Award**

**January 12, 2012, Waterford, Mich.** – The Journalism Education Association (JEA) has announced that Waterford Kettering High School Teacher Brian Wilson will receive the Distinguished Advisor Award. Wilson is one of two teachers in the Nation to receive this award, which is designed to honor outstanding high school advisers and their exemplary work from the previous year, as well as throughout their careers.

Wilson will be recognized during the Spring National JEA Conference in Seattle. He will receive \$500 which will be used to buy equipment for the school's yearbook classroom or to fund student scholarships to summer workshops.

The JEA is the only independent national scholastic journalism organization for teachers and advisers. Founded in 1924, JEA is a volunteer organization. Members of the Board of Directors, including the officers, are current or retired journalism teachers who have obtained their positions through national membership elections.
